

DONALD P. MYS SCHOLARSHIP
Scholarship to Graduating Senior

Qualifications

1. College Acceptance: Eligibility is extended to McBain High School graduates accepted in an accredited institution of higher learning and enrolled in the college of education with a career goal of teaching.
2. Scholarship preference will be given to those students identified as diligent and motivated workers with distinct financial need. Information will be sought through student application and nomination by school staff.
3. A student application must be completed and given to the counselor by the Friday before Spring Break.
4. All applications must be submitted to the school counselor by the Friday before Spring Break. Personal interviews may be requested by the superintendent. The selection will be made by the superintendent with consultation with the Mys family. Donald Mys will be invited to participate in the interview process.
5. The selected recipient will receive a \$1,400 scholarship award following the first successful semester in college. A grade report must be presented to the superintendent following the fall semester.
6. The scholarship is presented on a one-time payment basis.

STUDENT APPLICATION**

1. This scholarship is limited to a graduating senior who exhibits excellent character, above average achievement and is majoring in education.
2. The application must be completed in typed form and submitted to the counselor by the Friday before Spring Break.
3. The application should include the following:
 - a. What college have you been admitted to?
 - b. What grade level and subjects do you wish to teach?
 - c. What motivated you to pursue a career in education?
 - d. Provide a statement regarding your need for financial assistance.
 - e. Have you worked during the summer breaks and/or during the school year? If yes, please provide details.
 - f. Is there a teacher, school administrator or other school staff person who greatly impacted your life? If yes, please provide details.
 - g. Please describe your image of the ideal teacher.
